They performed the unfolding and refolding of the American flag with unbelievable precision and dignity, and offered the flag to Mrs. Gaydon with the utmost of respect and caring for her loss. It was a tremendous show of how much John was loved by everyone. He will be missed by everyone at Post 555.
